SERVICES

The Kindergarten, First grade, and Second grade students are serviced by whole group enrichment 30 minutes per week by a combination of the GT teacher and the regular classroom teacher. The identification process begins at the end of 2nd grade and was just completed this September. Students in grades 3-4 are serviced through pull-out in the Resource Room for a total of 180 minutes per week.

The Glen Rose 7-12 GT program is served by Honors classes, Advanced Placement classes, and college concurrent classes online and on campus. Students may also advance one year in math starting in the 8th grade. AP students take the AP exams each spring to qualify for college credit. As of now, we have 32 11th and 12th graders signed up to take these Exams in the Spring.
